Main Ideas

- ❖ Different views and perspectives exist with respect to how nationalism and national interest are related
- ❖ Differing views on national interest- peacekeeping vs. peacemakers
- ❖ National interest can influence foreign policy (acquisition of territory, land claims, signing of treaties...)
- ❖ There were numerous causes to the start of World War I
- ❖ Propaganda is an effective tool for ultranationalists
- ❖ There are many ways to respond to ultranationalism (appeasement,peacekeeping,war)
- ❖ Ultrationalism has resulted in crimes against humanity (Rwanda, Nazi Germany...)
- ❖ There are unintended consequences to self- determination (refugees)
