

Social 30-1 Assignment 1- Minor Written Response

Writing Guide (4 paragraphs)

Paragraph 1-3: Analyze source 1, 2 and 3

- ✓ Write a general introductory sentence based on the issue connecting all three sources (ie: Many struggle to agree on how much government intervention there should be within a nation's economy.) Paragraph 1 ONLY!!
- ✓ **Interpretation** of the source may include the following:
 - Demonstrate that you understand the source by making supportive statements that reflect a deeper understanding- Do discuss what you see in the source and how it relates to the greater issue you identified in your opening sentence.
 - Discuss the purpose and message (if a political cartoon)
 - Provide proof from the source to back up the interpretation
- ✓ Identify & explain the **perspective** of the source (ie: modern liberal, capitalist, socialist/collectivist, neoconservative, classical liberal, challenges facing modern democracies...)
 - Provide evidence from the source that supports this perspective
 - If possible, try to identify who may share this perspective and identify the values/ideas connected to the perspective- DO NOT just name drop.
- ✓ Discuss the **links** this source has to **Principles of Liberalism**
 - Be specific in your identification of the principle (example: economic freedom) and explain the connection to the source (supports or opposes the validity of the principle.

Paragraph 4: Identify the relationships

When analyzing a source for a common relationship, consider:

- Do all the sources SHARE a perspective?
- Do all the sources reveal the conflicting forces shaping the issue
- Do all the sources reveal possible solutions to an issue

Be sure to:

- ✓ Identify the relationship that exists among all the sources. (ie: levels of government intervention in an economy)
- ✓ Explain the relationship that exists among **all the sources**. Be specific in your discussion of how you see the sources relating to each other. (Always identify the sources you are discussing (Source I is similar to Source II in that...))
 - Straight from the rubric!!
